Dear Parent/Carers,

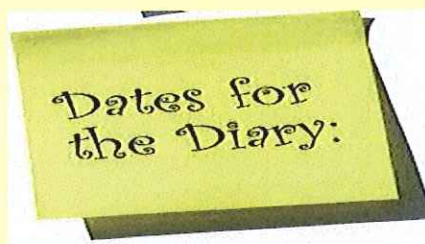

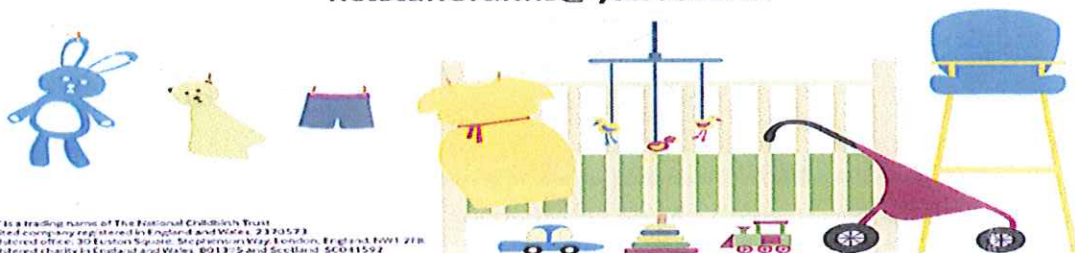

Reception Eye Tests

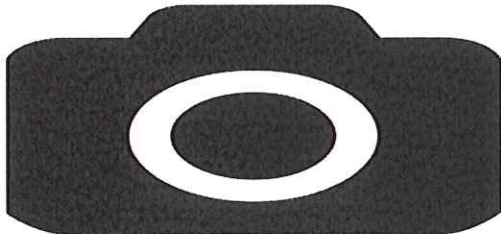
