Dear Parent/Carer,

A Questionnaire was recently sent out to all parents/carers asking for their opinion on aspects of the school. The results are as follows

Analysis of Questionnaire

126 Questionnaires were returned with 12 questions on each = 1512 questions overall.
89% of the questions answered were judged as **Agree or Strongly Agree**
6% of the questions were judged to **Disagree or Strongly Disagree**
5% of the questions were answered as **Don't Know**

A total of 9 letters were sent out to identified parents inviting them in to discuss issues raised on the questionnaire. The Governors and senior leaders are keen to address issues raised and this can only be achieved through open dialogue and discussion.

If children are not happy/safe at school then we have to ensure that this is dealt with. Bullying is always addressed and we try to work with parents and families of both children to achieve a resolution to enable children to enjoy coming to school and continue their learning.

Thank you to all the parents who are happy with their child's education at St Patrick's. If you do have any concerns please speak to your child's class teacher in the first instance.

Thank you to all the parents/carers who completed and returned the questionnaire.
